Current research interests	Mainly include various aspects of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy: clinical (predictors of disease progression and outcome, arrhythmias, characterization of the end-stage phase, medical and surgical management), imaging (studies of coronary flow reserve with PET, functional and prognostic relevance of magnetic resonance studies, echocardiographic screening and early HCM diagnosis, studies of pre-hypertrophic phenotype), genetic (prevalence and characterization of HCM-causing mutations, genotype-phenotype correlations, family studies, developmental aspects of HCM), molecular (studies of myofilament contractility, correlation of in-vitro findings with clinical and echocardiographic variables), pharmacologic (conditioning trials in patients with cardiomyopathies). These lines of research are being carried out in cooperation with several international institutions.
Clinical trial experience	Active participation in heart failure trials while in London (October 1991- July 1992), specifically focusing on heart failure. The post as research fellow at Hammersmith involved responsibilities in a clinical trial evaluating the effects of flosequinan in heart failure in the elderly. Principal investigator for the ATTRACT 1001 trial (AMICUS). Investigator and echocardiographic core lab coordinator for the trial "Ranolazine in patients with symptomatic hypertrophic cardiomyopathy: a pilot study assessing the effects on diastolic function, exercise capacity and symptomatic status" (EUDRA-CT number: 2011-004507-20). Investigator in the study Liberty HCM testing Elaclazine promoted by GILEAD and concluded in 2017. Has been selected as European coordinator for the forthcoming study PIONEER-HCM with new molecule Mavacamten, promoted by Myokardia.
